Registration Fee (non-refundable): \$25 per student per year. Due with first month's payment. Late Pick Up Fee: \$15 per 15-minute increment after 4:00 pm (rounded up). Families with repeat late pick-ups will be enrolled in the Extended Study program. No Charge if student is picked up within 15 minutes of school dismissal time.
